- The "Official Competitive" Competition is open to all EA Competitive Members, please note that Horses/Ponies require EA full registration with a current competition License.
- Please note that it is the competitors responsibly to ensure that their registration and membership is up t date prior to entering the competition.
- The organising committee reserves the right to alter or cancel any completion at its discretion
- Please note that any prizes not collected on the day of competition may be donated back to the Club,
- Remember: Online nominations do not permit late entries at all all entries via www.nominate.com.au
- This event will be conducted in accordance with EA rules except where FEI rules apply. Please refer to current rule book, 2014 EA Dressage Rules & Amendments
- The onus is on the competitor to know and follow the most current rules
- Scratching will be accepted up to the closing date. Refunds as per EA rules.
- Horses may compete in two consecutive levels only. But no more than three events per horse.
- Callers are permitted for all tests, according to EA Rules.
- Stallions must wear a "Green Disc" displayed on either the saddle cloth or bridle
- Horses or riders not entered in the event may not be ridden/or ride in the designated competition area during the event
- Visitors and Spectators are welcome at all times but must remain in or on the designated areas
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times
